The City of Weed adopts a two-year budget. The City operates on a fiscal year basis beginning July 1 and ending on June 30. The City of Weed's budget process begins in early spring of each odd-numbered year when each department develops and submits requests for the next two-year's operating budget and the five-year capital improvement program. In April and May, the City Council hold a series of workshops to discuss the requested budgets. The Final Budget is approved in June after holding at least one public hearing on the proposed budget and reviewing all appropriations and sources of financing.
